## PIONEER LIFE.... THE WORLD BEFORE CROCKER PARK

What was life like before there was Crocker Park?

It is hard to imagine a Westlake covered with dense forest, teeming with wildlife and even Indians, and a few pioneers who blazed the first trails into Dover Township (as Westlake was called back then).

Back in the 1800's wildlife was certainly abundant in these parts. Sure, we still see lots of deer. But a book written by one of the West Shore's original settlers, Rubin Hall, author of "Reminiscences of Pioneer Life" from his lifespan in this area from 1810-1910, gives a glimpse into a wilder past!

"Of the wild animals which were abundant when the settlers first came to Dover (now Westlake), there was the bear, wolves, foxes, raccoon, opossum, porcupine, mink, weasel, and black and gray squirrels without number. And of the feathered tribe, there was the wild turkey, partridge, quail and myriads of wild pigeons. These latter were very numerous and during their migratory season, the skies would be darkened by their flight."

Just as today's gardeners cuss out invasive deer, pioneer farmers also had trouble with wildlife. "Some of these animals were very destructive to the farmers crops," wrote Hall. "Deer would bound over the rail fences and feed off from the growing wheat fields, and the raccoons would visit the corn fields when the corn was large enough for roasting ears, and climbing on the stalks and break them down and make the pioneer's field look as if a drove of hogs had been on a rampage!"

Hall was born in the area on June 18, 1827 - long before Crocker Park could have been imagined!

"I was born in a pioneer's log cabin, which was surrounded with forest trees inhabited with wild animals. Although the changes which have taken place since then have been rehearsed at old settler's meetings and other public gatherings, I will mention a few of them," he read at Rose Hill in Bay Village, Sept. 10, 1910, in memory of the Pioneer life of Dover for the past 100 years. "When our fathers and mothers with their families, came to settle in this, then wilderness country, with their ox carts and lumber wagons over rough and almost impassable roads, it took them five or six weeks and sometimes longer to make the journey from their homes in the eastern states to their prospective homes in the wilderness country of the west."

Today, in our area, we celebrate the Crocker Stearns Extension, which connects I-90 to I-480 in just minutes!

"Now," marveled Hall in 1920, "If a person wishes to take a trip to Boston, he can take a Pullman car at Cleveland, at 5 p.m., and reach Boston the next day before noon. If he wishes to come from Boston to Dover he can take a car which is provided with every convenience and comfort, at 5 p.m. and reach his home in

Dover in time to take dinner with his family the next day."

The days of cell phones and text messaging would also be incomprehensible to Hall.

"Sending and receiving news the change has been wonderful," he said as the 19th Century turned. "My first remembrance of sending and receiving letters was when they were sent by stage coach, and when they arrived at their destination after some days or weeks, there was twenty-five cents to be paid as postage. Now a letter with a two-cent stamp attached can be sent to any part of the United States, and with the aid of the mail trains on our railroads, and the electric lines it can be delivered in a very short time."

In these days of super grocery stores, Giant Eagle and Aldi, Hall celebrated improved farm implements!

"In the matter of the agricultural implements for the carrying on the farm, there has been a very great change," he boasted. "From the scythe to the mowing machine; from the sickle and the cradle, to the reaper and binder; and from the flail with which the farmer could thresh out by hard work a few bushels of grain in a day, we have come to the thresher and the separator with which he can have 1,000 bushels of grain put into his granary, in one day."

Still, the world long before Crocker Park was already becoming too busy for him!

"The social life of the pioneers, from my point of view, has not changed very much for the better. Notwithstanding the hardships and the privations of the pioneer and his family, there were many things which helped to cheer and support them with their burdens, which we do not have at the present day. There were the log rollings, the husking bees, the paring bees, the spelling schools, and the singing schools.

All of these helped to furnish social enjoyment of the first order, both to young and old. It was not necessary in the good old pioneer days to spend an invitation card to bring neighbors together for an afternoon or evening visit, where a real enjoyable and social time was sure to follow."

With an outpouring of community support, the West Side Catholic Center has been able to grow that "welcome" into "welcome home."



The West Side Catholic Center offers hospitality, hot meals, a women and children's shelter, clothing, household goods, advocacy and emergency services to those in need at no charge. The West Side Catholic Center relies on hundreds of volunteers to maintain its services. Our volunteers consist of individuals, church and civic groups, student organizations, and area businesses.

Community support includes partnerships with other food and emergency service providers, such as many other churches and faith-based organizations. A United Way Partner, West Side Catholic Center is also a member of the Cleveland Food Bank and receives food donations from Harvest for Hunger, as well as regular deliveries of in-kind donations and grocery surplus from local businesses throughout Greater Cleveland.

Grounded in faith, hope, love and respect for those we serve, the West Side Catholic Center assists all who come in need of food, clothing, shelter and advocacy.

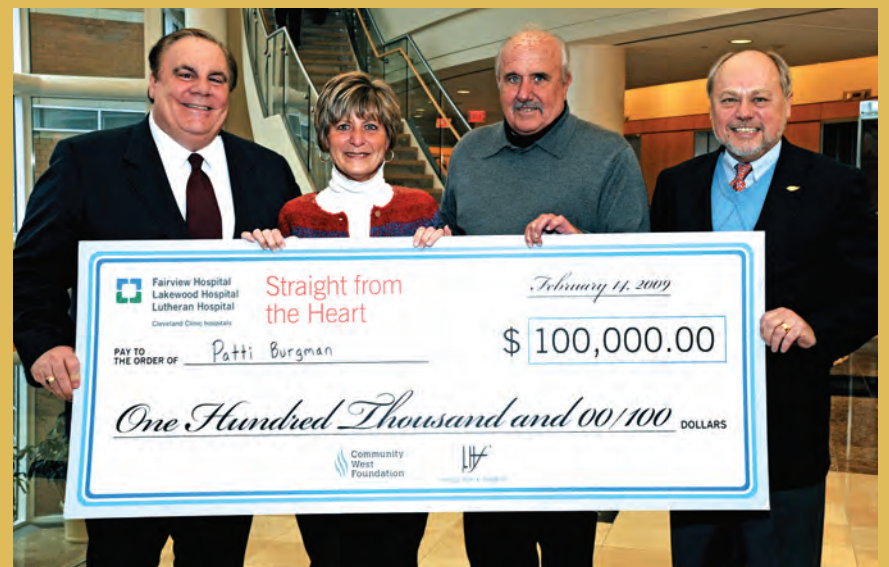


