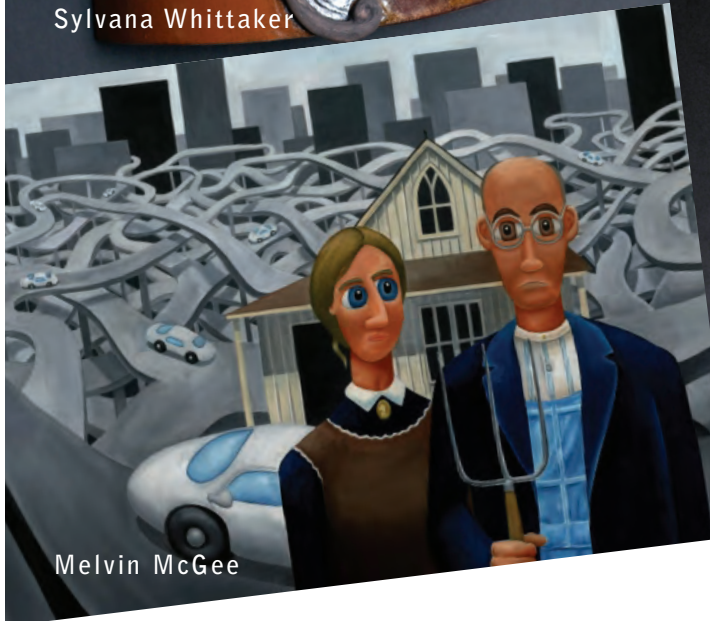

In the Garden with Smith & Hawken

Eating locally has very much been in the news lately. Farmer's markets and roadside farms produce some of the freshest produce around. But there is a way to eat even fresher. Why not make this the year you eat fruits and vegetables grown right in your own backyard.

Our grandparents thought nothing of growing most of their own fruits and vegetables. Canning and storing food in a root cellar were common practices just a generation or two ago. If they ate tomatoes in January, they were canned tomatoes from their own garden, grown the previous summer. Now we've become accustomed to buying tomatoes year-round and wondering why they don't taste as flavorful as we remember.

Make this the year you start to produce some of your own food. Discover how flavorful veggies are fresh off the vine. You'll know where and how that tomato in your salad was grown. And while you're at it, grown your own salad as well!

If you've never had a vegetable garden before, start small, maybe with container gardening. You can easily plant up a few tomato or pepper plants and put them on your patio. They would be close to the house for easy watering and you can watch your plants grow "up close and personal."

Herbs would be another great "starter" plant for your garden. Basil, cilantro, oregano and mint are all easy to grow. (However, be careful with mint. It spreads quickly. You may want to grow it in a container and not in the ground.) Think of your fresh-off-the-vine tomatoes with fresh-out-of-the-garden basil. That is a match made in heaven.

Try growing a variety of lettuces this year. Many of the loose leaf lettuces are considered "cut and come again," meaning you can make several cuts from the same plant before you use it up, unlike head lettuce which produces one cutting per plant. These lettuces are so easy and inexpensive to grow from seed that there is no reason you can't have fresh salad every night this summer.

Be sure to plant only vegetables you like to eat. If you hate cabbage, don't plant it. The same holds true for peppers, carrots, or any other veggie. If you don't like to eat it, you won't like to grow it.

So make this the year you go a little more local with your food choices. You grandparents would be proud.
