

“Going Green” gets easier for the homeowner each year as new products come onto the marketplace. You might want to make this the year you alter your lawn care routine to make it “greener”.

Using an organic method of lawn care not only benefits the lawn, but the surrounding environment as well. Fewer chemicals on the lawn means less chemical runoff draining to the lake and rivers. Fewer chemicals on the lawn also means fewer chemicals to track into the house on shoes and pets.

To begin your organic lawn care program, start with a soil test. This can be done by purchasing a test kit or contacting the county extension service for a kit. When you receive the results, amend the soil as directed.

Next, aerate the lawn. This provides air circulation to roots, aids water retention and helps control thatch. If thatch is present and less than ½” deep, remove it with a rake and top dress the lawn with a thin layer of compost or leaf humus.

Select the correct type of grass for your area and use.

When mowing, set the blade high and mow frequently. A longer cut helps smother out weeds and prevents their spread. It also offers more leaf area for photosynthesis, thereby increasing lawn’s health. Do not let the grass get too long, however, or too much of the leaf will be removed when it is cut, and the lawn will have to recover from this.


Water your lawn deeply (about six inches of water), slowly and infrequently. This will help produce a deeper root system.

Develop a tolerance for a few weeds. A weed here or there in an otherwise healthy lawn is not a major problem and are easy to hand dig throughout the summer. In the fall, dig out the perennial roots you missed and apply corn gluten meal to prevent germination of weed seeds the following year.

Remember to leave your grass clippings on the lawn to add organic matter, and consider using your mower to chop fallen leaves. This will feed your lawn and eliminate raking, as well.

A “greener” lawn does not need to mean a chemically dependent lawn. With a few little steps, your lawn, and the surrounding environment, can be healthy and green.



Community Challenge Honors David T. Dombrowiak



David T. Dombrowiak, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Community West Foundation, was honored as the 2009 recipient of Community Challenge's Annual Exemplar Award on June 10 at Westwood Country Club.

"We are privileged to honor David Dombrowiak for his long-standing commitment to the mission of Community Challenge," said Debora A. Rodriguez, President and CEO of Recovery Resources. "Mr. Dombrowiak's thoughtful nature and entrepreneurial spirit have had a profound impact on the non-profit community in this region."

Through Community West Foundation, Dombrowiak spearheads support to community needs through attention to the poor, the homeless, those fighting addiction and mental health issues, and comfort to the suffering and dying.

The Foundation provides a variety of financial and administrative services to donors, professional advisors, and colleagues through its Invest West® Program, which ensures local philanthropy serves community need.

Dombrowiak emphasized the universal spirit of compassion that suggests charity starts at home as he accepted the award.

"Work is love made visible," he said in quoting the poet Kahil Gibran. "He sees our true nature as beings who participate in the great Love and Divine Power of our Creator and share in that Love of humanity by work, by doing, by actions."

In advocating for those in need locally, he paraphrased a Vietnamese folk tale about heaven and hell:

In Hell, everyone is given all the food they want with a pair of chopsticks a yard long making it impossible to feed oneself;

In Heaven, the same applies, but people use the chopsticks to feed each other, their neighbors!

The moral of the story, he said, guides his leadership and the mission of Community West Foundation. "We have enough rice, enough food, enough housing, enough medical supplies, enough of everything to make sure that no one is without food, shelter or medical care. We just need to share," he said.

In the first three months of 2009, Community West Foundation provided \$213,000 in grant support to

an array of exemplary local programs. This includes Lakewood Christian Service Center (which assist community members who are jobless, hungry and/or in crisis), The Center for Families and Children (which reaches out to over 4500 West Side families suffering with severe mental illness), The Ed Keating Center's Sober Living Residential Center, Second Harvest Food Bank, Youth Challenge (for children with disabilities), The National Alliance for the Mentally Ill, and Providence House (a safe haven for young children).

Dombrowiak was joined at the award ceremony by several Community West Foundation Trustees, including Dr. Ted Castele, Fred DeGrandis, William Baker, Dr. James Magisano, Bill Oatey, Chuck Rini, Sr., Robert Warren, Jr. and Bob Yaroma.

"As Trustees, we are asked to share our time, our talent and our treasure," reported Dombrowiak. "Our grants committee distributes treasure, but that is not enough. Our time is used in site visits to the agencies in our area becoming involved in community organizations and initiatives. Our talent used by our Colleagues Program to help smaller agencies receive planned gifts.

"We use all our resources to make the Community West Foundation the Community Foundation for the West Side - Locally owned and operated- Neighbors helping neighbors. Using our chopsticks wisely, feeding each other!"

Community Challenge established the Exemplar Award in 2006 during their 20th Anniversary Celebration to honor members of the West Shore community who have demonstrated a long and distinguished record of exemplary service and support of its mission -keeping kids healthy and drug free. Former recipients of the award include Mr. Fred M. DeGrandis, CEO and President of the Cleveland Clinic Regional Hospitals, Dr. Dennis Allen, former Superintendent of the Rocky River City School District, and The Honorable Pamela E. Bobst, Mayor of Rocky River.

Community Challenge was initially formed as Rocky River Community Challenge, Inc. in 1984. The organization has developed a program of services based on the concepts of awareness, prevention and early intervention. In December of 1993 the name was changed to Community Challenge due to the organization's growth and development in municipalities outside of Rocky River. On January 1, 2008, Community Challenge partnered with Recovery Resources, a local non-profit organization that has been helping people triumph over mental illness, alcoholism, drug and other addictions for more than 50 years.




Run for the Young
